

# SMOKE ALARMS & FIRE

This house is equipped with **battery** powered, radio **interconnected** fire alarms.



Smoke alarms are required by law, do not remove them!

1) **IF the alarm goes off**, it will trigger every alarm on the same floor. First check and make sure there is no smoke or fire in *any room*. IF THERE IS SMOKE OR FIRE CALL 911 RIGHT AWAY, SEE BELOW.

3) **IF the alarm goes off by accident**, you can *disable* the alarm by pressing and holding the button on the nearest alarm that is causing it.

4) **IF the alarm chirps** (quick beeps), the batteries may be getting low.

In the event of low batteries or accidental trigger, you can *temporarily* disable the alarm by removing batteries, but you must **contact property management** right away.



## IN CASE OF FIRE

**Fire extinguishers** are located in the **kitchen** on each floor. To use them: remove the pin, point at the fire, and depress the handle.
