

# SMOKE ALARMS & FIRE

This house is equipped with **battery** powered, radio **interconnected** fire alarms.



Smoke alarms are required by law, do not remove them!

1) **IF the alarm goes off**, it will trigger every alarm on the same floor.

First check and make sure there is no smoke or fire in *any room*.

IF THERE IS SMOKE OR FIRE CALL 911 RIGHT AWAY, SEE BELOW.

2) **IF the alarm goes off by accident**, you can *temporarily disable* the alarm by pressing and holding the button on the alarm that is causing it.

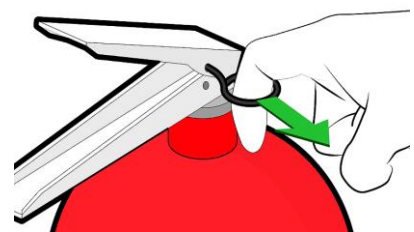
3) **IF the alarm chirps** (quick beep every min), the batteries may be getting low.

If you suspect the alarm is not operating correctly, or batteries are low, **contact property management** right away.

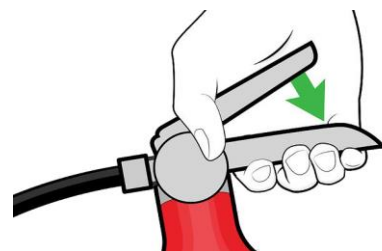


## IN CASE OF FIRE

**Fire extinguishers** are located in the **kitchen** on each floor. *To use them*: remove the pin, point at the fire, and depress the handle.



1. Remove pin



2. Aim and squeeze handle
